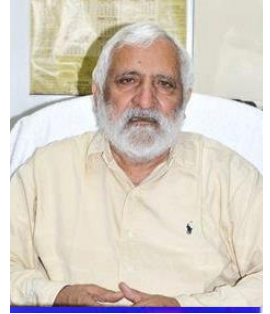


SHANTI DEVI ARYA MAHILA COLLEGE, DINANAGAR

Courses

College is providing teaching in the subjects related to faculty of Arts, Commerce, Science and professional courses. The college is running 8 B.sc and 6 professional courses Viz, BCA, BBA, BSc(IT), B.Sc (Bio-Tech), B.Sc (FD), B.Com(Prof.) and also 9 PG Department and 5 Diplomas, 13 Add-on courses. It is matter of great pride that college has been granted two **B.Voc courses in (i) Software Development (ii) Financial Market and Services** by UGC. We are also conducting the **PMKVY** projects in various subjects. It is a matter of pride that the college has every course that the students of the area and around aspire to do. Students can opt. for MA English, Punjabi, Hindi, Economics, Political Science, M.Sc in Computer Science& IT and FD and M.Com at Post graduate level and also PG diploma Fashion Designing, Computer Application and UG Diploma in Stitching and

Tailoring, Diploma in cosmetology and Computer Application at under Graduate level. UGC has given 13 add on courses i.e. Communication Skills, Apparel Designing, Cosmetology, Taxation, E-Commerce, Bio-Technology, Travel and Tourism, Web Designing, Internet, Bio-informatics and interior decoration.
