## Courses

College is providing teaching in the subjects related to faculty of Arts, Commerce, Science and professional courses. The subjects taught include English, Punjabi, Hindi, History, Sanskrit, Political Science, Economics, Maths, Computer Science, Home Science, Music, Sociology, Fine Arts, Zoology, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Education, Fashion-designing, Computer Application, Psychology and Public Administration. **The college is running 8 B.Sc and 6 Professional courses Viz, BCA, BBA, B.Sc (IT), B.Sc (Biotech), B.Sc (FD), B.Com and also 9 PG Departments, 4 UG Diplomas, 2 PG Diplomas and 11 Add-on courses.** We have been granted **B.Voc courses in (i) Software Development (ii) Financial Market and Services by UGC. It is a matter of pride that we have been granted B.A(Social Studies) by GNDU, Amritsar. Recently, College has got Beauty & Wellness course under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY).** The college has every course that the students of the area and around aspire to do. Students can opt for MA English, Punjabi, Hindi, Economics, Political Science, M.Sc in Computer Science & IT and FD and M.Com at Postgraduate level and PG diploma Fashion Designing, Computer Application and UG Diploma in Stitching and Tailoring, Diploma in cosmetology and Computer Application at under Graduate level. UGC has given 11 Add on courses i.e. Communication Skills, Apparel Designing, Cosmetology, Taxation, E-Commerce, Bio-Technology, Travel and Tourism, Web Designing, Internet, Bio-informatics and interior decoration.
