Title of the Practice: Mentor Mentee System

The institute is keen to attain the fulfillment of the goal of imparting holistic education to women folk by creating a better environment of better opportunities for the posterity and fostering the spirit of harmony , peace and sustainability through its unique mentoring system .The institution is keen on empowering women by providing them skill oriented education as well as supporting the emotionally and morally to become good human beings.

Objectives of the Practice

- To create an informal informative association between mentor and mentee.
- To provide congenial atmosphere to mentees to gain knowledge about skill based education.
- To provide better guidance and support to the students' needs.
- To build the overall personality of the student, who can contribute to nation building activities.
- To identify new sectors of skill development.
- To financially empower girls and improve their livelihood by creating opportunities for them in this backward and border area.
- To inculcate idea of economic independence in minds of the girls who are part of patriarchal family system having orthodox approach towards women.

The Context

The institute is situated in the semi urban and backward area which is just a few kilo meters away from international border of Pakistan. People living in this area have a typical patriarchal mind set. Even career oriented girls are rendered jobless once they get married as they leave their jobs and move. Some girls are not allowed to go for higher studies aspirants don't allow them to move to big cities .The institution began by taking smaller steps towards vocational training of girls and engaging them in training that would provide relevant skill oriented education. Special mentor – mentee groups were made to provide personal care to each and every student.

Mentor-Mentee System

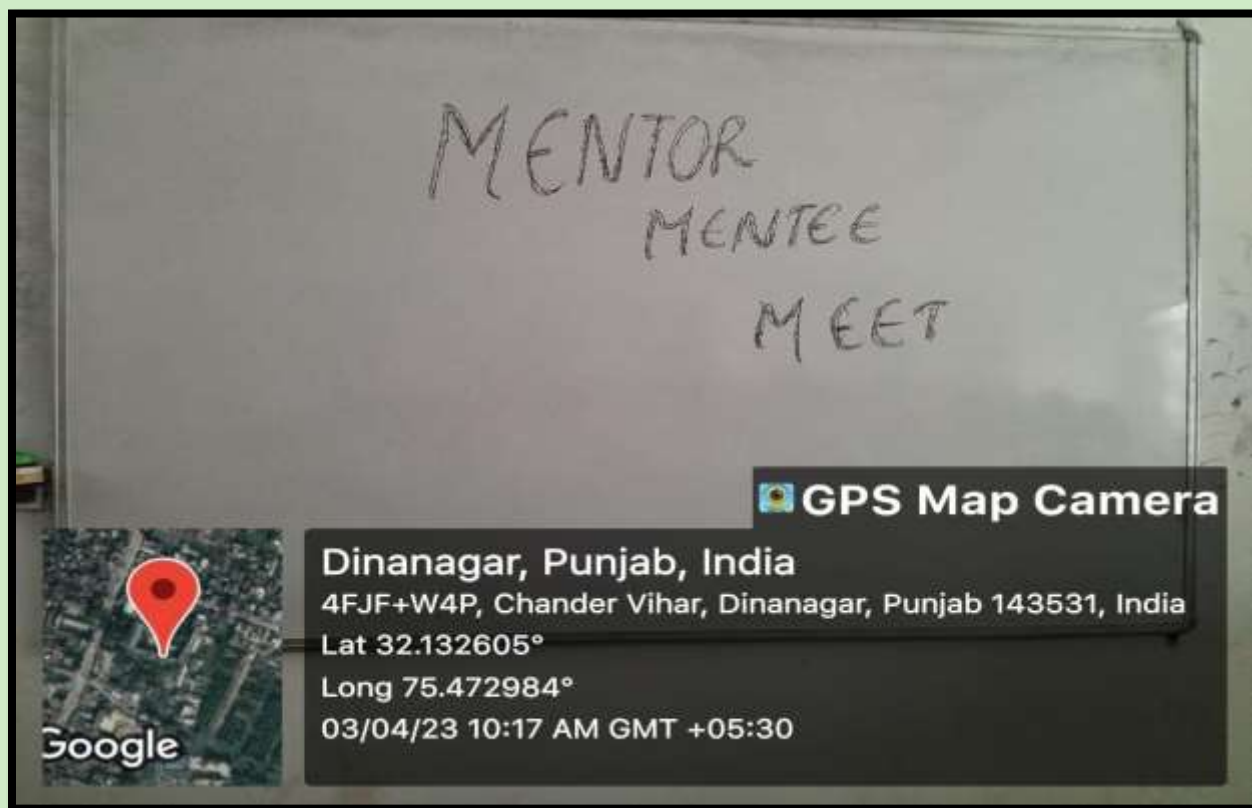


The Practice

Two formal meetings with individual students or group of 20 students in a month are arranged by the mentors assigned by the counseling cell. In these meetings the students mention their academic background, interests and their aspirations and goals, family background and expectations from the college. The mentor looks at the attendance and performance of individual student and suitable measures are taken to improve her performance. Parents are intimated about their wards performance and separate parent meetings are held in chronic cases to report. Students are real so encouraged to participate in literary, fine arts, performing arts and sports depending on their interest and talent. Workshops on personality development and career counseling are arranged by inviting competitive authorities. Students identified with personal difficulties and low self-esteem are

guided to the counseling cell of the college and given special attention. Having recognized the need for up lifting status of women socially as well as economically the institution began skill oriented courses twenty five year back as per need of the hour. The institute has been offering degree courses in computer application, bio-technology, Fashion Designing and vocational courses in cosmetology, fashion designing and garment construction and library science.

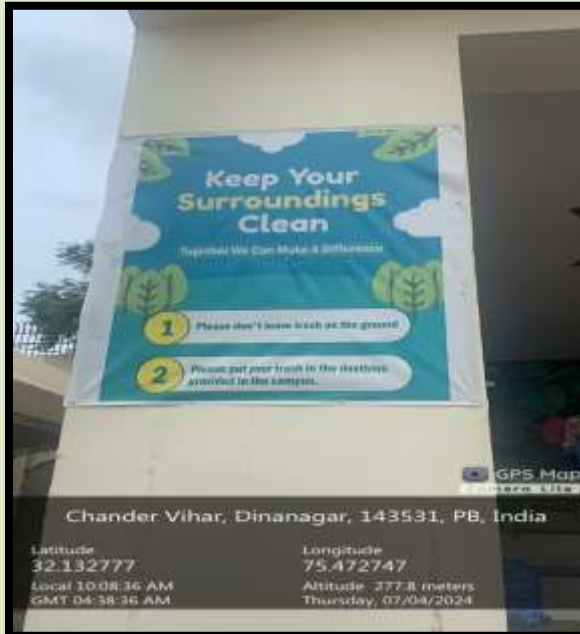

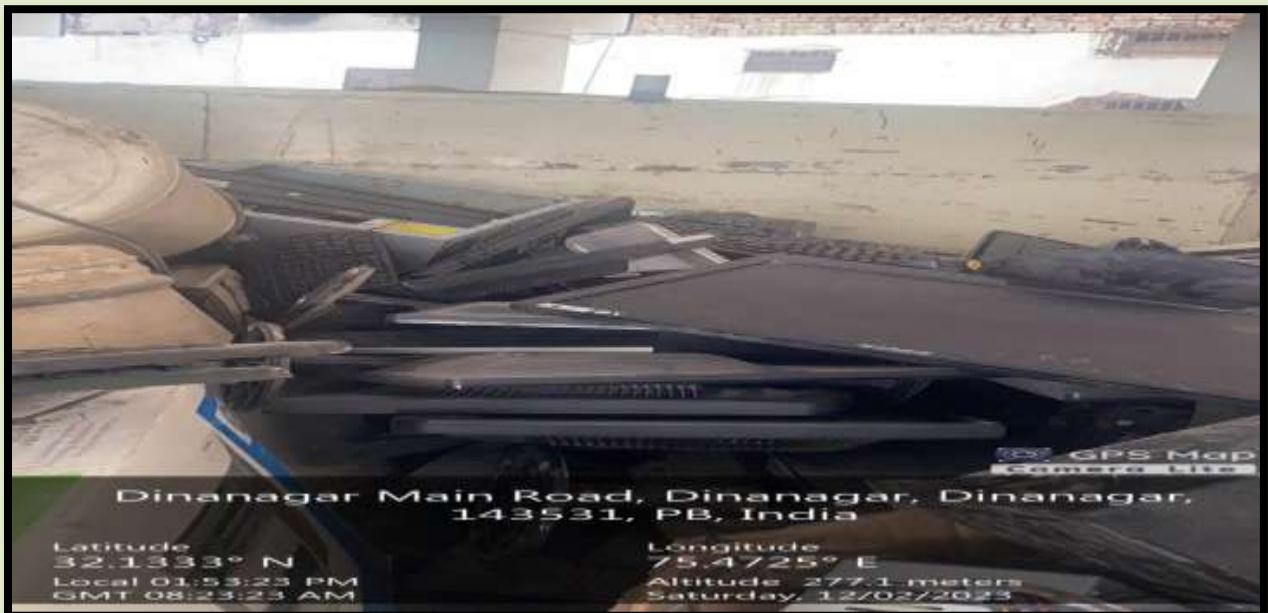
