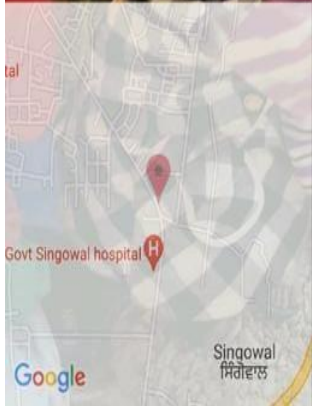


On 7th Day Closing Ceremony of 7 Days Special NSS Camp

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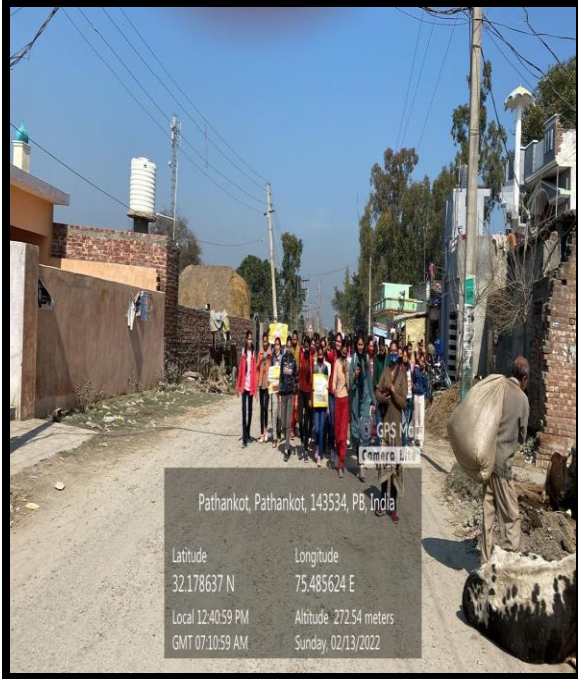

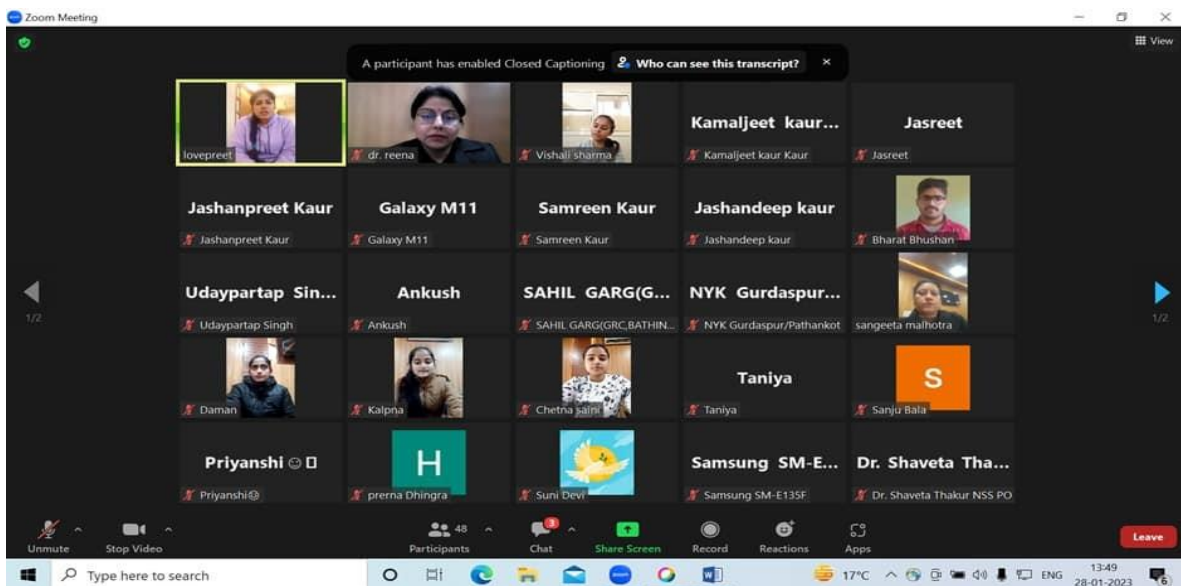
